Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS)

<u>3 days prior to the procedure:</u> Hold all blood thinners and non-steroidal based products, i.e. Aggrenox, Aritra, Brilanta, Persantine, Ticlid, Coumadin, Plavix, Dalteparin, Fragmin, Argatroban, Pradaxa, Whole Iron, Mobic, Advil, Aleve, Motrin, Ibuprofen, Celecoxib, Diclofenac, Diflunisal, Etodolac, Indomethacin, Ketoprofen, Ketorolac, Nabumetone and Naproxen. It is OK to take Tylenol.

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Day prior to procedure: Take all routine medications as you normally would, unless otherwise instructed. NO SOLID FOOD AFTER MIDNIGHT.
Day of Procedure: Only take blood pressure, seizure, transplant and respiratory medication with a sip of water at least 4 hours prior to procedure.
If your procedure is after 12:00pm, you may have clear liquids until Clear liquids include, water, carbonated soda, broth, black coffee, tea, premier protein clear, flavored water, Gatorade, apple juice, ensure clear
Insulin and Diabetic Medications: Hold all diabetic medications the day of your procedure.
Please do not wear any make-up, cologne or perfume or aftershave products.
You cannot work or drive on the day of your procedure, therefore please arrange to have a responsible adult give you a ride home from the facility. You cannot take Uber, Lift or Taxi home.
